Chairman O'Neill opened the workshop at 6:00 pm and introduced Town Manager Asanza to review the budgets presented.

Town Manager Asanza gave an overview of the budget drivers and started with Memorial Park. Larry Mead from the Memorial Park Committee was

present to give an overview of the park improvement project and the funds needed for the project. The Council discussed wages for the park gardener, the service contract costs, and costs for replacing playground equipment. A workshop will be scheduled to go over the park funding in more detail.

Conservation Commission – Mark Koenigs was present for the Conservation Commission and thanked the Council for their continued support.

Public Works

The Council discussed wages, downtown maintenance, and equipment rentals with Director Chris White. There was a discussion on the future of the transfer station and a possible fee structure.

Wastewater

The Council discussed current and future projects as well as equipment needs with Director White.
