The answers below are provided in response to questions and comments submitted by prospective Bidders.

In the Drawing it is showing a 20' external halyard aluminum flagpole but in the site improvement specs it is describing 40' internal halyard aluminum flagpoles. Verify the size of the flagpole.

Answer: The flagpole shall be a 20' flagpole. Please see revised Section 10 75 00.

A few of the flagpoles & flagpole uplighting shown on C-200 are in direct conflict with trees that are to remain. Verify intention with the tree and flagpole arrangement.

Answer: Please see revised Drawing C-200 for revised positions.

Will the street opening fee be waived since the work is for the town?

Answer: Yes the street opening fee will be waived.

Please provide elevations for the Pétanque court.

Answer: Elevations have been provided on the revised Drawing C-302.

There is a callout for a "new kiosk" on sheet C-302. There is no detail showing a kiosk. Please verify scope for the kiosk.

Answer: The existing kiosk will be relocated as part of the scope to the location shown on Sheet C-302. No new kiosk will be provided as part of this project.

On sheet 302 there are two -4" drain lines and one -6" drain line shown discharging into the

existing catch basin. Will that structure be able to take 3 new cores on the same side without losing structural integrity?

<u>Answer:</u> Condition and size of existing catch basin has not been verified at this time. Sheet has been revised to tie one of the lines into C-302 into adjacent drain manhole instead.

Detail 1-E-201 shows a concrete cap under areas subject to vehicular traffic. Are all the stone dust paths considered "vehicular"?

Answer: Only paths of 10-feet wide or greater are considered vehicular.

On sheet C-200 there are callouts for "blend stone dust pathway into existing pathway. Would these areas be figured as concrete in alternate 2 or will they remain stone dust in both scenarios?

Answer: Existing stone dust would remain in these locations up to the extents of the concrete walkway edge for Alternate 2. No new stone dust or concrete aprons would be required for the locations indicated on sheet C-200 as "Blend New Stone Dust Pathway...".

All testing is being done by the contractor, including earthwork, concrete, paving, and electrical correct?

Answer: All testing will be completed and paid for by the Contractor.

All the underground electrical is stubbed up at the northern face of the building. There is existing landscaping at this location. Are we to replace any landscaping that is to be removed due to electrical installation or loam and seed the disturbed area?

<u>Answer:</u> Existing landscaping is to be restored to existing condition after electrical installation.
